

Route to the campsite

This document is meant to provide you with all information you need for the final part of your journey to the Haarlem Jamborette campsite and ensure a quick and safe passage of all participants and their luggage. Please follow the instructions carefully because the devil is in the detail ;-)

General information and instructions

- 1. Depending on your means of travel (see items 1 through 4 below) you will have to go to either Gate C (the main gate for the groups) or Gate B where you will be welcomed by one of our welcoming parties who will give you further instructions. There are also other gates but these serve other purposes.
- 2. On Saturday 5 August 2023, Gate C will be open from 08:00 to 20:00 CET and Gate B from 08:00 to 18:00 CET.
- 3. On Sunday 6 August 2023, Gate B will not be open. The few groups that arrive this day will have to go to Gate C regardless how they travel.
- 4. If, for whatever reason, you arrive at a gate after closing time, please call the number indicated on the gate for assistance.
- 5. Please ensure that your group is complete before you proceed to a gate. If needed, plan to meet on a different location and wait until everybody has arrived.
- 6. From the gate you will walk to your subcamp under guidance of one of our runners.
- 7. Your vehicles will have to be unloaded and any luggage that cannot be carried by your group will have to be transferred to our trailers that will be transported to your subcamp by us.
- 8. Any of your trailers will be transported to your subcamp by us as well.
- 9. Under certain circumstances it may be decided by our welcoming party that a fully packed vehicle (for instance a truck / lorry) will be guided directly to a subcamp by one of our runners.
- 10. Vehicles and trailers that will stay at the campsite will be parked in the long-term parking sites. You can only pick up your vehicle at the end of the Haarlem Jamborette or in absolute emergency situations.
- 11. An A5-sized form clearly indicating the name of the contact person / driver plus phone number and the name of the group and the subcamp must be put under the windscreen of the vehicle or attached (waterproof) to the trailer once parked so we know who to contact if needed.

Assistance

Please call the Jambo Office (+31852733400) if, during your journey, you run into any issues which you cannot solve yourself. The staff member who answers the phone will refer you to the person who can assist you.

1. Arrival by bus, car or van

All vehicles must go to Gate C at the following address: Burgemeester Michielsenweg 1165 MX Halfweg GPS position: 52.392852, 4.742932

Option 1: route from highway A9:



Please note that trucks / lorries heavier than 3.5 tons (3,500 kilograms) may not cross the train crossing (close to the Halfweg - Zwanenburg train station) on this route and must approach the campsite via the Wethouder van Essenweg from the northeast as indicated in the route below. Busses are allowed to cross.

Option 2: route from highway A10/A5:



Last 1.2 kilometre

Once you have reached the crossing of the Wethouder van Essenweg and the Burgemeester Michielsenweg please follow the Jamborette road signs.

From that location there is a one way street to Gate C.

At the end of the street there is a parking site where you will be welcomed by a welcoming party.

Please note that the Wethouder van Essenweg is an important thoroughfare and blocking it must be avoided.



2. Arrival by Jamborette-bus from the (air)port

The Jamborette-bus will bring you to Gate C.

3. Arrival by train at the Halfweg-Zwanenburg train station

- Once you arrive at the Halfweg -Zwanenburg train station, it is a 600 meter walk to Gate B (close to the crossing of the Wethouder van Essenweg and the Burgemeester Michielsenweg) where you will be welcomed by a welcoming party.
- Please follow the route and any Jamborette road signs and be careful crossing streets.



4. Arrival by bicycle (Gate B)

Please go to Gate B (see item 3 above)
